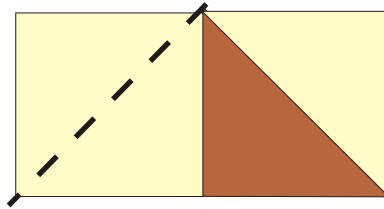
BLOCK 12 - Flying Geese

This is the last month. We are making the Flying Geese units this month. The instructions for Assembly of the quilt are also on the website this month. It is a rather large file, but printing should not be a problem.

REQUIREMENTS

From Beige print fabric cut:
36 - 2½" squares

From Assorted fabric scraps cut:
18 - 2½" x 4½" rectangles



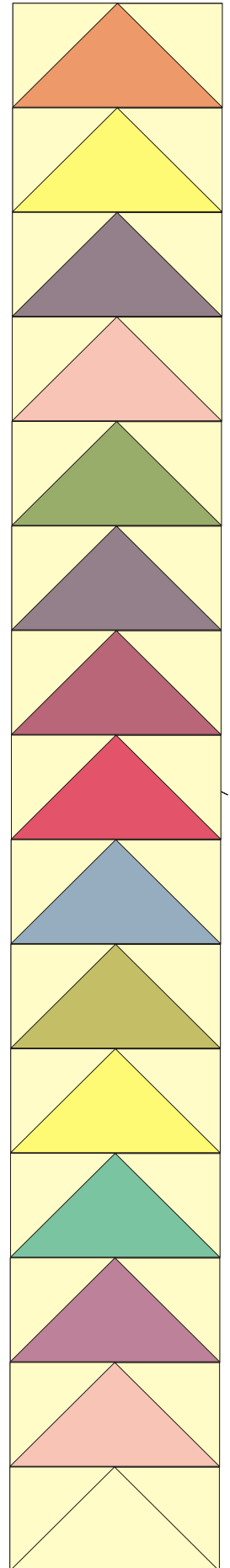
Position a 2½" beige square on a 2½" x 6½" rectangle and stitch diagonally from corner to corner on the beige square. Trim the seam allowance to ¼" and press towards the triangles. Repeat for the opposite corner of the rectangle.

Make 18 of these.

Sew 12 together to make the large flying geese block.

Sew 3 together to make the small flying geese block. Make 2 of these.

Congratulations you have finished a years worth of blocks. You can now sew them all together and enjoy your hard work.
