

## Block 1

# JACOB'S LADDER

This block is made using rotary cutting and quick piecing methods

Fabric 1: Background fabric

Cut 2 – 5" squares

Fabric 2:

Cut 1 – 2 ½" x 25" strip

Fabric 3:

Cut 1 – 2 ½" x 25" strip

Fabric 4:

Cut 2 – 5" squares



Charlee's Quilt

### Charlee's Quilt

Fabric 2 = Purple fabric

Fabric 3 = Green fabric

Fabric 4 = Pink fabric

### Ted's Sampler

Fabric 2 = Red check (cut into a 15" and a 10" strip)

Fabric 3 = 1 - 15" strip red 1, 1 - 10" strip mid green

Fabric 4 = Fawn pattern 1

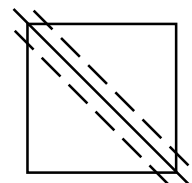
### Half-square triangle blocks

On back of both background 5" squares draw a diagonal line.

With right sides facing align background 5" square with fabric4 - 5" square and sew ¼" away from both sides of diagonal line.

Cut in half along diagonal line and press open with seams to dark side to form 4 ½ square triangle blocks.

Measure and trim if necessary to 4 ½" squares.

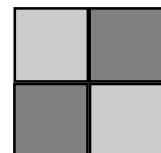


### 4-square blocks

Sew fabric3 and fabric2 strips together along the long side. (15" strips together and 10" strips together if doing Ted's Sampler). Press seam to dark side.

Cross cut strip into 2 ½" slices to form 10 – 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles.

Butt seams together and sew into 4-square blocks.



### Putting it all together.

Lay block out as shown in photo.

Using chain piecing methods sew the block together. Press.

*Congratulations - First block finished.*
