

Block 2

CHURN DASH

This block is made using rotary cutting and quick piecing methods

Fabric 1: From your background fabric

Cut 2 – 5" squares

Cut 1 – 4 ½" square

Fabric 2:

Cut 1 – 1 ¾" x 19" strip

Fabric 3:

Cut 1 – 2 x 19" strip

Fabric 4:

Cut 1 – 1 ¾" x 19" strip

Fabric 5:

Cut 2 – 5" squares



Ted's Sampler

Please note: There is an error in this block. The middle strip was not cut wide enough so I had to add a background strip on the outside.



Charlee's Quilt

Ted's Sampler

Fabric 2 = Mid green & Red 1 (9 ½" strip of each)

Fabric 3 = Fawn 1 & Fawn 2 (9 ½" strip of each)

Fabric 4 = Red 2 & Red check (9 ½" strip of each)

Fabric 5 = Dark green

Charlee's Quilt

Fabric 2 = Lime Green

Fabric 3 = Yellow

Fabric 4 = Orange

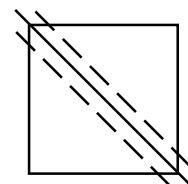
Fabric 5 = Yellow

Corner patches

On reverse side of the 2 background 5" squares rule a diagonal line from corner to corner

With right sides together align Fabric 5 - 5" squares to background 5" squares and sew ¼" away from ruled line on both sides.

Cut along ruled line. Press seam to the dark side. Trim to 4 ½" squares.

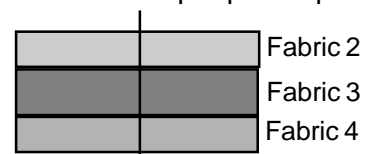


Striped patches

Sew a Fabric 2 strip, a fabric 3 strip and a fabric 4 strip together along the long sides.

Press seams towards dark fabric. (Please note: For Ted's Sampler make 2 - 9 ½" strips)

Trim edge and cut strip into 4 – 4 ½" squares. (There is 1" of fabric extra to help square up blocks)



Making block

Layout patches to represent finished block.

Using chain piecing and quick sewing methods to finish block

Give it a good press and clip threads.
