

Block 9

CHARLEE'S STAR

This block is made using rotary cutting and quick piecing methods. (This block is also called Stepping Stones)

Fabric 1: background
cut 1 – 3 ½" x 16" strip
cut 2 – 2" x 8" strips
cut 4 – 2" x 3 ½" Rectangles
cut 8 – 2" squares
cut 1 – 3 ½" square

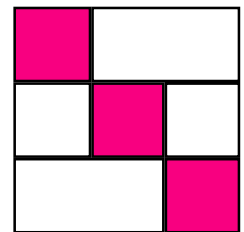


Fabric 2: Aqua
Cut 4 – 3 ½" squares
Cut 8 – 2" squares

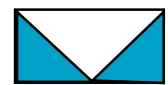
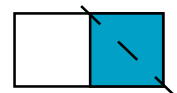
Fabric 3: Pink
Cut 1 – 2" x 16" strip
Cut 1 – 2" x 8" strip

Sewing Instructions

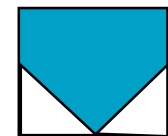
Sew the background 3 ½" x 16" strip and the pink 2" x 16" strip together. Press to the dark side. Cross-cut this strip into 8 – 2" slices. Sew a background 2" x 8" strip to each side of the pink 2" x 8" strip. Press to the dark side. Cross-cut into 8 – 2" slices. Sew these slices into a 9-patch square using the diagram as a guide.



Sew an aqua 2" square on to each end of a 2" x 3 ½" background rectangle, using the "flippy corner" method, to make a flying geese unit. (Make 4)



Sew a background 2" square to each corner on one end of an aqua 3 ½" square, using the "flippy corner" method, to make an extended flying geese unit (Make 4).



Sew these 2 flying geese units together using diagram as a guide.



Layout all units using the photo as a guide and string piece them together. Press well.
